Training with a Seeing Eye[®] dog.

Once you are accepted into the Seeing Eye program, you begin training at the school's 60-acre campus, nestled in historic Washington Valley, New Jersey. Your “classroom” is also located on the streets of nearby Morristown, about 35 miles west of New York City. During your 19- to 26-day stay, you will live on campus in a spacious, comfortably furnished private room with a private bath.

Students are required to pay tuition costs themselves as their commitment to owning and caring for their Seeing Eye dogs. Once you leave the campus, you own your dog. For a first-time fee of \$150, students receive their dog, its initial training and equipment, instruction with the dog, room and board, as well as round-trip transportation from anywhere in the United States or Canada. Payment may be made in interest-free increments over a period of years so there is never any financial hardship.
